Terms and Conditions

1. Parties of Contract:

A: EURASIA -Institute, registered as a private supplementary school with the Berlin Senate according to § 9 of the Berlin Private Schools Act at the address Obentrautstraße 72, 10963 Berlin, Germany and represented by the signatory

B: STUDENT intending to apply for German language preparatory course and German university application

2. Application:

The STUDENT confirms that he wishes to study at EURASIA according to the terms and conditions below. EURASIA hereby confirms acceptance of the STUDENT's application to study at EURASIA

3. Conditions of Application: The STUDENT must fulfil the following application requirements:

- a) The STUDENT must be a healthy candidate, having no illnesses which might influence his/her studies.
- b) The STUDENT must be at least 18 years of age on the date of signing this contract. If not the contract must be signed by the parent or guardian taking full responsibility for the STUDENT
- c) The STUDENT must meet the qualifications required by a German university if intending to apply to study in Germany.
- d) All legalised and translated transcripts required for university application must be handed in with this contract.

4. Premium Course: the EURASIA premium service includes tuition, all course materials and exam fees, free repetition of classes if the student does not obtain satisfactory exam results, free examination retakes after repeating a level, success guarantee (free extension of course until the student passes the highest exam for the period booked)1 organized cultural/social (afternoon or evening depending on what is presently on offer) activities per week (not including transport fare or entry fees), 1 weekend outing per month (not including transport fare or entry fees), free individual university placement counselling with full active support of our study consultant until place at university has been found, and an internship placement after completion of the C2 exam if required for university application. It is not possible to convert from premium to standard once the contract has been signed, neither can refunds be made if the student decides not to make full use of this package.

5. Period of Study:

The duration of study and the number of teaching units to be taken during that period of time are detailed in the application form. The date of commencement is specified in the letter of confirmation provided for visa application. This date may be postponed by up to three months should delays in obtaining the visa occur or in the event that are too few applicants to start a class in the month applied for. The student must reconfirm the starting date TWO WEEKS before arrival by sending an email to admissions@eurasia-institute.com EURASIA does not accept responsibility for any circumstances or costs arising as a result of failure to do this.

6. Obligations of EURASIA and services provided to the STUDENT during the programme:

- a) After payment of the application fee EURASIA will apply for confirmation of the student's general aptitude for university studies in Germany. This will be provided in the form of a conditional letter of admission or confirmation of application status from one of EURASIA's partner universities. It neither represents a guaranteed place at that university nor does it oblige the applicant to participate in studies at that university. The exact conditions of entrance to that university are detailed in the letter.
- b) Provide German language tuition full-time (6 academic hours per day) as a super-intensive course, 5 days a week Monday to Friday. The precise number of hours is as detailed overleaf on the application form.
- c) Experienced and qualified teachers of German as a foreign language with special phonetics training and special preparation for the university entrance examinations (TestDaF, DSH). Tuition groups on average about 12 to 15 participants. Maximum is 18 students.
- d) Participation in internal examination system with up to 6 levels (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2). STUDENTS who pass each level with the corresponding certificate will continue to the next level. STUDENTS who do not pass the level exam will be given one chance to retake the exam. If they fail a second time, they will have to repeat classes of that level again.
- e) Orientation lecture on studying in Germany shortly after arrival, followed by individual interview with Head of Studies to ascertain and formulate individual needs and wishes. After this, support is offered to the STUDENTS as required.

7. Obligations of the STUDENT:

- a) The STUDENT must confirm the authenticity of all documentation and the correctness of all personal information. All costs as well as legal consequences resulting from failure to observe this point will be borne by the STUDENT.
- b) The STUDENT is obliged to complete the language studies according to the length of course applied for. If the student is absent from more than 20% of classes then he/she will be ex-matriculated – tuition fees will not be returned. Should the STUDENT have a visa for university studies and not attend the EURASIA preparatory courses EURASIA is obliged to inform the immigration authorities.

8. Fees and Methods of Payment:

- a) Non-returnable Application Fees and Courier Fees – to be paid when sending in your application
 - i) Returnable Deposit for Tuition fees – payable immediately on receipt of university conditional offer by fax/scan and before the visa application is made.
 - ii) Health, liability and accident insurance for the duration of your stay – to be paid in whole on receipt of visa and before arrival
 - iii) Outstanding payments for all other services including bank charges deducted are to be paid on arrival
- b) Consultancy Charges: Any consultancy or service charges levied in addition to the costs of EURASIA products and services (see EURASIA price list and application form) by the sales representative or agent are left to the discretion of that representative and are not regulated by EURASIA. STUDENTS must keep a copy of all contracts, receipts, invoices and communication with EURASIA.
- c) Methods of Payment:
 - o Payments may be made via Western Union Money Transfer, bank transfer, Cash Deposit, Bank Draft or via www.paypal.com. Please note that in most cases you will need to carry all extra bank charges.

9. Termination of Contract: If the contract is terminated before visa application has been made, a cancellation charge of 35% of the sum of invoice will be levied. This contract cannot be terminated under any circumstances after obtaining the visa. Course fees will not be refunded under any circumstances. In particular, if the student breaks off from the booked course prematurely, this in no way entitles him to a refund of tuition fees. Furthermore, finishing the course early as a result of passing the relevant examination early or by jumping classes due to good performance will not entitle the student to a refund.

10. Refunds in case of visa refusal: Course fees deposits and other fees paid will be refunded provided that the visa was refused in written form by the German Embassy or Consulate. In order to make the refund we require the original letter of refusal from the embassy, a copy of your passport with all relevant pages and the return of all original documents given to the student for visa application. Costs incurred by EURASIA will be deducted from the deposit made (courier fees, bank charges, appeal fees etc.). Refunds will not be made under any other circumstances.

11. Validity of Contract: This contract is valid from the date of signing by the STUDENT and EURASIA. Should any disputes arise out of this contract, such disputes will be regulated according to German law. Place of jurisdiction is Berlin, Germany.

- For the Accommodation Package:
1. **3-month student residence (1300,00 €)**
 2. **3-month room in a private residence (1800,00 €)**
 3. **3-month host family with breakfast (2400,00 €)**

1. Validity of Accommodation Contract: The accommodation contract is to be signed before arrival in Germany and is valid from the day the student or the responsible agent of the student has confirmed written to the EURASIA Institute. EURASIA agrees to provide the student with an accommodation for the previously booked period.

2. Quality Standards and Rent: a member of the EURASIA student-service team chooses all the accommodations after a preliminary visit and a personal interview with members of the family or owners. All chosen locations meet a minimum standard.

3. Living Conditions: The student has a single room in which he can study, sleep and store personal belongings. Cooking facilities will be made available to the student. The student may use a washing machine once a week free of charge in a host family. In a student dormitory the laundry is always charged extra. Arrangements for the usage of all communal facilities and rooms should be discussed in detail with the owner of the accommodation after arrival. The cost of board is not included. If board is required this must be booked and paid extra to the EURASIA Institute in advance.

4. Payments due before arrival: The Accommodation Package fee is payable **in full** before arrival in Germany. This total payment includes the basic rent for one or three months (including heating and electricity) plus a one-off administration fee including the following services: help with police registration formalities, help with opening a bank account, advice concerning health insurance issues, help finding a doctor and assistance at German immigration authorities (does not include residence permit or visa fees). If booked accommodation is cancelled a cancellation fee will be charged: 35% 2 or more weeks in advance, 100% for cancellation less than two weeks in advance.

5. Payment of rent: The institute will transfer the rent of the booked period directly to the account of the owner of the accommodation.

6. Key-money and Breakage Deposit: A minimum deposit of **€ 300** (depending on the type of accommodation) is to be paid to EURASIA in addition to the package fee on arrival as provided for by German law and before moving into the accommodation. This will be used to cover breakages, loss of keys, damages not covered by the insurance, failure to pay rent and unpaid telephone bills. The fee is returnable after moving out of the accommodation one month after receipt of written confirmation from the family that everything has been left according to their satisfaction and that there are no outstanding bills or damages. The student should return the keymoney release form signed by the landlord along with the confirmation of registration with the police registration at the new address. The fee will be returned to the student by bank transfer only. Cash returns are not made under any circumstances.

7. Rental Period and Notice: If the student is not satisfied with the accommodation he/she must inform the EURASIA-Institute and the landlord/landlady of the accommodation within two weeks and a second accommodation will be organised free of charge. If a replacement accommodation is required after this period, a charge of **€100** per move is payable to the EURASIA-Institute. All removal costs are to be borne by the student. The rental period begins on the day of arrival and lasts for exactly for the booked period. In the first two weeks after arrival in Berlin, you may give notice to the EURASIA-Institute and the landlord/landlady at any time to change the accommodation at the end of the first month. After the first two weeks, one month's notice to EURASIA and the landlord/landlady is required to change the accommodation. If you move out without giving notice, the EURASIA Institute will not organize you a new accommodation and the amount of the Accommodation package fee is still payable.

8. Insurance: The student must be covered by the institute's insurance programme for the duration of the language course. The EURASIA Insurance covers health, accident and third-party liability insurance. Damages must be reported to the institute immediately.

9. Damages: The Student is responsible for any damages caused by the student and is obliged to report all damages in the room which he/she noticed on arrival to the landlord of the accommodation or the EURASIA Institute. The student may be made responsible for all other damages which are spotted and reported by the landlord after the student has left the room. When the student moves out of the room, it should be left properly cleaned and all furniture should be in the original positions. The Student must respect the house rules of the accommodation.

10. End of Contract: The contract ends after the booked period from the day of move-in in the accommodation. Students who wish to remain in their accommodation are entitled to sign a private rental contract with the landlord of the accommodation.

11. Rules and Regulations: The student should observe the following rules concerning living with the host family. If these rules are not observed, then the family or EURASIA may terminate the contract without notice. In such cases, EURASIA may decline to find a new host family for the student.

11.1. The student may not invite friends to the family's home without the permission of the host family. Under no circumstances should he let strangers into the family's house when he is alone at home.

11.2. The student should keep his room clean and tidy, and should make sure that common rooms such as the toilet, bathroom and kitchen are also kept clean. Cooking methods which release a lot of fat or oil should be avoided for reasons of cleanliness. The kitchen is to be left clean at all times. Male students, in particular, should pay attention to cleanliness and hygiene of the sanitary facilities. The student should respect the customs and house rules of the family and should not smoke, drink, organise parties or use any of the host family's personal belongings without first asking for their permission. The same applies when visiting the host families of fellow-students from EURASIA.

11.3. If the student is going to return home late at night, or is not planning to return at all, then he should inform his host family, so that they do not have unnecessary worries. If the student spends the night at the host family's house of another fellow-student, then he must pay € 15 per night.

11.4. The student must pay for any breakages that are not covered by the third party liability insurance.
