

Guidelines for Students Requiring Foundation College



1. Every foreign student whose qualifications obtained in the home country do not meet the direct entrance requirements for a German university must go to the Foundation College.
2. The student will learn German 7 months at EURASIA INSTITUTE. During this time, he will send his application directly to the Foreign Students' Office of the chosen university or Polytechnic. **Applications are not sent to the Foundation College!**
3. The University or FH will issue a postponed admission for the chosen degree programme, on the condition that the student must visit the relevant course at the Foundation College (**T, W, M or G-course**).
 - **T-course:** for all students wishing to study degrees in technical subjects, engineering or mathematics
 - **M-course:** for all students wishing to study degrees in medicine or biology
 - **W-course:** for all students wishing to study degrees in business and economics
 - **G-course:** for all students wishing to study degrees in social sciences
4. The student must take an entrance exam for the Foundation college in these subjects:
 - **T-course:** GERMAN + mathematics
 - **W, M und G-courses: only GERMAN (source: foundation college Munich)**
5. After successfully passing the **entrance exam** (the points necessary depend on the number of applicants and the amount of places available at the Foundation College) the one-year course begins at the Foundation College. Number of Lessons per week at the Foundation College:
 - **T-course:** approx. 10 hrs. German, 10 hrs. Mathematics & computer science, 12 hrs. physics & chemistry; in addition depending on degree programme chosen: 2 hrs. electronics or computer science
 - **M-course:** approx. 10 hrs. German, 16 hrs. chemistry, biology & physics, 4 hrs. mathematics, 4 hrs. Latin-Greek medical terminology
 - **W-course:** approx. 10 hrs. German, 10 hrs. Mathematics, 10 hrs. Economics and business studies, 2 hrs. social sciences
 - **G-course:** approx. 10 hrs. German, 6 hrs. literature, 4 hrs. History, 6 hrs. English or Latin (depending on degree programme)
6. After one year students take the University Entrance Examination (**Feststellungsprüfung**)
 - **T-course:** written and oral examination in GERMAN, maths, physics or chemistry, oral examination in physics or chemistry (= subject not chosen for written examination!)
 - **M-course:** written+ oral examination in GERMAN, chemistry/biology, physics or mathematics; oral examination in physics or mathematics (= subject not chosen for written examination!)
 - **W-course:** written+ oral examination in GERMAN, maths and economics; oral examination in business studies
 - **G-course:** written+ oral examination in GERMAN, history, literature or social sciences; oral examination in literature or social sciences (= subject not chosen for written examination!)
7. After successfully passing the University Entrance Examination the student can proceed to matriculation for the chosen degree programme.
8. Beginning of 1st semester of degree programme
