

Work and Study Opportunities in Germany



All Foreign Students may do Part-time Work

- All foreign students who come to Germany on a student visa may do part-time work.
- Officially they may work 90 days per year or 180 half-days per year for 20 hours a week, the first 50 days in any year are completely free of social insurance contributions
- After completing their studies, foreign students may remain in Germany for one year in order to search for permanent employment
- Once they have found work, they may apply for permanent residence status and stay in Germany indefinitely if they so wish
- EURASIA assists students from any country with placement at a German university
- On arrival, our team helps students to get their work-permit from the immigration
- Students who book a Premium course will get a free internship which may be paid

Short-Term Company Internships

- All students from the old EU countries may do an internship in Germany
- Students from EU countries may do an internship in Germany with a work permit
- Non-EU students should have a valid work visa in order to do an internship
